## Baltimore Regional Fair Housing Group Jurisdictions (Unshaded)

- Jurisdictions in the Baltimore metropolitan area that receive federal housing funds directly from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- Other, smaller jurisdictions in region -- Carroll and Queen Anne's Counties:
  - Receive federal housing funds via the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD).
  - Smaller jurisdictions have same duty to affirmatively further fair housing, but Maryland DHCD, as direct recipient of HUD funds, carries out this Regional AI planning process for those funds.
