- Varying surface

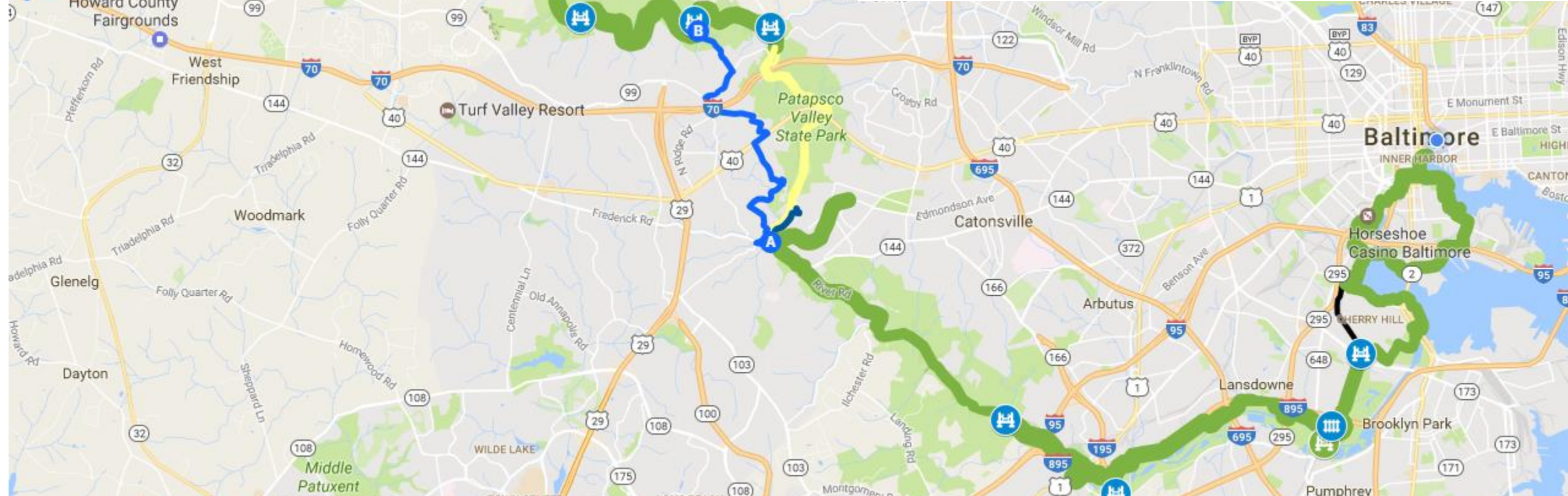
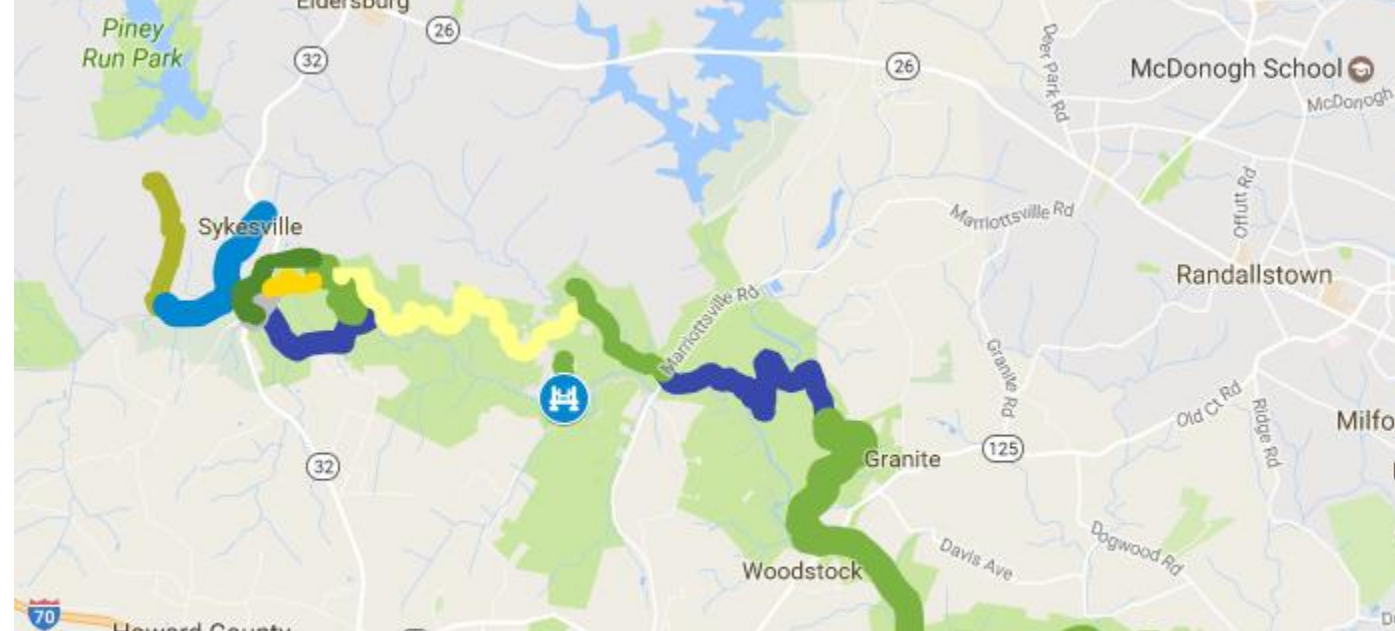
Current Conditions
