ADULT TRAUMA SERVICE



- Interactive tools to educate adult/young drivers
- Debilitating effects of TBI after a motor vehicle crash (impaired and distracted driving)
- Focus on Baltimore City

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL SYSTEM FOUNDATION

- Distracted driving simulator to enhance 20 pre-prom safety program
- Programs at high schools and at R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center



IMPACT TEEN DRIVERS



- Train the trainer programs - first responders, health professionals and educators
- Teaching teens the dangers of distracted driving
- *Be the Change* program at 10 schools throughout the state (Carroll)

BYKE COLLECTIVE



- Teach bike mechanics, safe ridership and community values in Baltimore City's marginalized neighborhoods
- Value of pedestrian visibility
- Youth ambassadors and professional contractor

FREE BIKES 4 KIDZ



- Supplement Howard County's bike education program in up to 12 schools
- Refurbish donated bikes, provide education, and donate bikes to underserved children

MARYLAND STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION

- Expand on OC WalkSmart, DriveSmart, BikeSmart campaign
- Cheswick (10 years) rebranded for rural and urban areas
- Outreach personnel to teach pedestrian safety with Cheswick
- PSAP highest priority corridors Baltimore, Anne Arundel, and Howard Counties



MARYLAND STATE POLICE MOTORS PROGRAM



- Provides free training for motorcyclists
- Operated by Maryland State and local law enforcement agencies
- Includes classroom and practical training with individualized feedback for riders

MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

- Supporting eye tracking software for driving simulator
