

# **Self Certification of the Regional Transportation Planning Process**

Resolution #22-2

July 27, 2021





## Why Self Certification?

- The Metropolitan Planning Rule directs all Transportation Management Areas (i.e., urbanized areas with a population of 200,000 or more) to certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is being carried out by the State and the MPO in accordance with all applicable requirements
- Concurrent with the submittal of any proposed Transportation Improvement Program to the FHWA and the FTA





### What Are These Applicable Requirements?

- 1. Metropolitan Planning Regulations
- 2. Clean Air Act (Conformity Determination)
- 3. Nondiscrimination General
- 4. Nondiscrimination Civil Rights (Civil Rights Act of 1964)
- 5. Nondiscrimination ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990)



### What Are These Applicable Requirements?

- 6. Nondiscrimination Aging
- 7. Nondiscrimination Gender
- 8. Nondiscrimination Disabilities (Rehabilitation Act of 1973)
- 9. Involvement of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises
- 10. Equal Employment Opportunity
