Background

- In 2024 MTA was awarded a RAISE grant to complete a Preliminary Design and Environmental study for the Reisterstown Plaza Metro Station Transit Oriented Development (TOD).
- The study will include Complete Streets considerations and accessibility improvements between the station, proposed TOD, and existing facilities.

Benefit

• This effort will compliment the ongoing TOD efforts by proposing infrastructure improvements at the station and proposed development.

Apportionment

• This amendment will obligate \$4.6M in RAISE funds to FY 2025. There is no state match because of the project's location in a disadvantaged community.

Schedule

• The project will be led by MDOT and will kick off after the grant is executed.
