Establish a clear communication channel between the work group, LOTS operators, MTA, and other stakeholders.



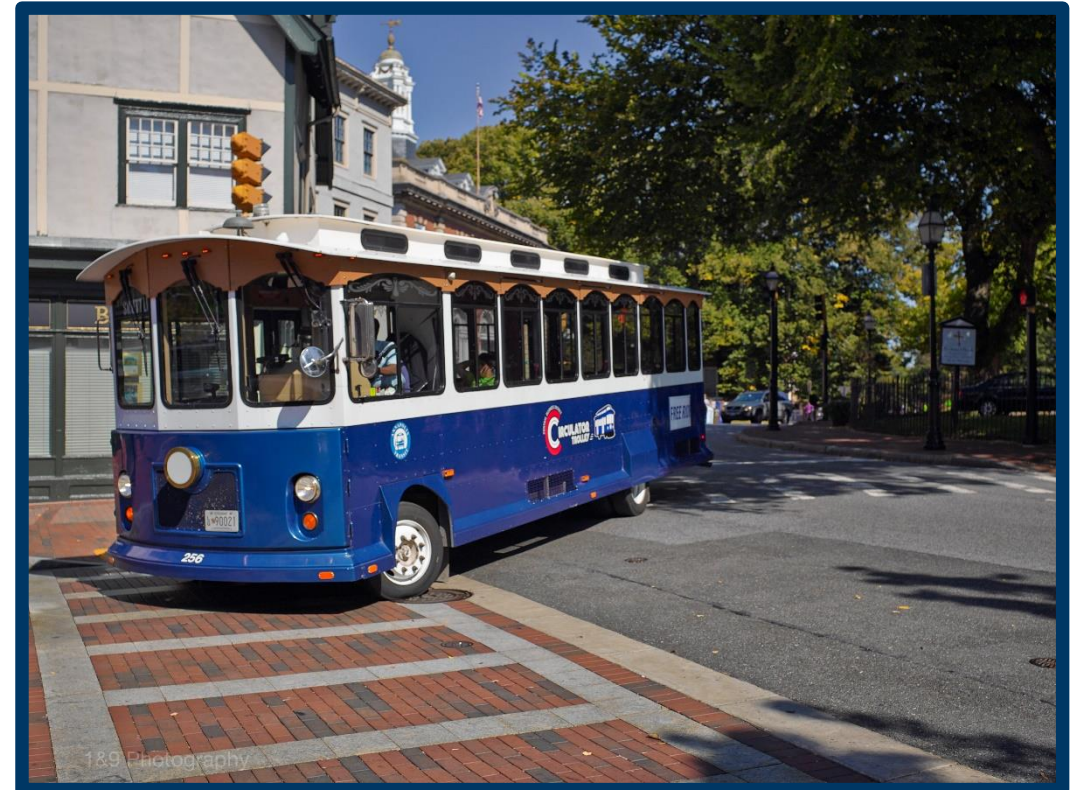
Key Considerations and Coordination

Technical Assistance: Explore opportunities to provide technical assistance to LOTS operators on planning, operations, and funding.

Policy Recommendations: Develop policy recommendations for the BRTC and other decision-makers to support LOTS coordination and growth.
