- Displayed to the right are the 2018 Populations, Average Household Sizes, Death Rate Multipliers and Vacancy Rates for each Election District/City
- A sample equation for a Population Estimate based upon the current U\&O's issued through July (164) and the Averages of variables for each Election District/City
- The result is an increase of $\sim 20$, resembling the increase in in Population since December 2018

## Definitions

## - Housing Unit

- A house, an apartment, a mobile home or trailer, a group of rooms, or a single room occupied as separate living quarters, or if vacant, intended for occupancy as separate living quarters. Separate living quarters are those in which the occupants live separately from any other individuals in the building and which have direct access from outside the building or through a common hall. For vacant units, the criteria of separateness and direct access are applied to the intended occupants whenever possible.


## - Household

- A household includes all the people who occupy a housing unit (such as a house or apartment) as their usual place of residence.
- A household includes the related family members and all the unrelated people, if any, such as lodgers, foster children, wards, or employees who share the housing unit. A person living alone in a housing unit, or a group of unrelated people sharing a housing unit such as partners or roomers, is also counted as a household. The count of households excludes group quarters. There are two major categories of households, "family" and "nonfamily."
- Household is a standard item in Census Bureau population tables


## Housing Unit Model

- Housing Unit Estimates = Previous Year Housing Units + U\&Os issued this year

- In December 2018 (highlighted below) the projected total Housing Units was 65,023. Since, there has been 164 U\&O's issued, for an updated total of 65,187 in July 2019

## Household Projection Methodology

- To project the number of households, using data given by the Maryland Department of Planning, Carroll County planning staff reviewed the annual number of Use and Occupancy (U\&O's) permits by election district from the last decade (2006-2016). Carroll County experienced a constant decline in growth from years 2006 to 2012, however, the County started to gradually increase in growth from 2013 to 2016.
- The average number of permits was calculated for each election district and each number was used as a guide for the projections from the 10 -year timeframe. Carroll County has a total of 14 election districts. The table to the right is the averages for all 14 Election Districts:

## Population Projection Methodology

- The population projections are derived from the data provided by the Maryland Department of Planning. To develop the projections, the staff applied the average household size for each of the 2010 Census Block Group to the number of households projected. This number was generally descending out to 2045 assuming a continued overall decrease in average household size. Because the average household size for the County has been declining for the last 25 years ( 2.85 in 1990, 2.81 in 2000, 2.74 in 2010, and 2.69 in 2015), staff calculated accordingly in reducing the number.
- For reference, The U.S. Census Bureau Population Estimates Program estimated a 2018 population of 168,429, while the Round 9 projection was 168,540 , a difference of only $0.1 \%$.
