Overview & Status Update

County ERAP Funds to Date — December 3rd update

- \$27.1M ERA 1 directly through Treasury
 - over 91% spent, request for additional funds submitted
- \$27M ERA 1 through State of Maryland
 - over 84% spent
 - \$20M ERA 1 additional through State of Maryland (agreement underway)
- \$30.5M ERA 2 America Rescue Plan Act
- County application portal opened March 4, 2021







Application Period	Launched March 4, 2021		
Eligibility	Up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI) Prioritizing HHs with Income up to 50% AMI		
Who Can Apply?*	Landlord/Owner/Tenant(s)		
What is Covered?			
• Rent	NEW: Up to 18 months of arrearages, not occurring prior to April 2020		
UtilitiesFees	NEW: Up to 18 months of arrearages, not occurring prior to April 2020 Non punitive fees associated with living in the property		
Tenant Documentation Requirements **	Verification of Household Income, COVID-19 Pandemic Hardship Attestation, Client Authorization Form, Current Leasing Agreement or Month to Month Agreement, and Current Rental Ledger indicating arrearages		
Waiver – Back End	Yes. Waive any Self-Help Measures for a Period of 90 days following Receipt of the Rental Assistance Payments. Withdraw or dismiss any previously-filed proceeding(s)



Rent burden: 50% of income, Overcrowded: 1.5 people per room

Social Factors

 African-American and Latino population, population below poverty, number of single parent households (HH)


Pandemic Effect
