 MPO - Metropolitan Planning Organization


 Continuing, Cooperative & Comprehensive (3-C) planning process

# What We Do: Plans & Programs

- ✓ Long-Range Transportation Plan
  - Every 4 years
  - Current: Maximize 2040 (2020-2040)





- ✓ Short-term Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
  - Developed 1x/year or every other year
  - Current: 2018-2021 TIP
  - Amendments (as needed)





# What We Do: Plans & Programs

# ✓ Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

- Annual budget and plan of work by BMC staff and local jurisdictions
- Developed every 2 years





#### Conformity Determination

- Evaluation of impact of planned and programmed projects on region's air quality
- Developed each year with TIP,
   every 4 years with long-range plan





# What We Do: Plans & Programs



- ✓ Public Participation Plan
  - PAC may review and make recommendations for changes each year
  - Updated in 2014; PAC currently reviewing prior to public review and comment in February 2018

- ✓ Limited English Proficiency Plan
- ✓ Title VI Plan
  - Both updated in 2015




