### **GOVERNOR'S FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT**

June 15, 2018

- Governor Larry Hogan Announced Additional \$890 Million for Northbound I-95 Express Toll Lanes (ETL)
  - Expanded \$1.1 Billion program will provide two ETLs for more than 10 miles from north of MD 43 in Baltimore County to north of MD 24 in Harford County.










### **Expanded Program**

  Old Joppa Road, Clayton Road





- New ITS System




