- June August 2022: BMC staff technical scoring
- August October 2022: Draft & Approval of Preferred Alternative
- November 2022 January 2023: Analysis of Effects of Projects
 - Air Quality Conformity
 - Travel Demand Modeling
 - Environmental Justice Analysis
 - Natural and Cultural Resources Coordination & Analysis
- July 2023: TC/BRTB Vote on Resilience 2050





Candidate Project Submittal

- Regionally significant major capital projects
 - >**\$5 million**
 - Increase system capacity or identified as regionally significant by BRTB
- **Timeframe for projects:** Extends from FY 2028 FY 2050
- Existing & Committed: Projects that will be complete or will have requested all funds by FY 2027 (the last FY covered by the TIP)
- Fill out the project submittal form as completely as possible
 - Project information is necessary for travel demand modeling and technical scoring
 - Provide current \$ cost estimates if available
 - MDOT MTA and MDOT SHA have tentatively agreed to calculate project costs
- Policy Score:
 - High Priority 5 projects max (30 points)
 - Medium Priority 4 projects max (20 points)
 - Low Priority unlimited (10 points)
 - Demonstrated MDOT Financial Support (additional 10 points)
