- February 6 – Release draft for 30-day public comment
- March 7 – Deadline for Public Comments
- April 1 – Review comments and consider recommendation for BRTB
- April 22 – Approval at Elected Officials Meeting of BRTB
- April 26 – Submit to FHWA/FTA/EPA
- May – BMC prepares contracts for local signatures
- July 1, 2025 – Begin FY 2026 Work Program
