## **Overview**



 When MTA obligates a grant, we have to have the funds in the year of obligation

 MTA is taking actions necessary to obligate a number of grants





# Bus and Paratransit Vehicle Overhaul and Replacement

## **Background**

- MTA is replacing bus and paratransit vehicles
- Obligating CMAQ funds with pre-award authority

#### **Benefit**

 Replacing buses and paratransit vehicles supports fleet capacity and replaces aging equipment

## **Apportionment**

 This amendment will obligate \$44.85M of CMAQ funds and \$7.5M in state match

#### **Schedule**

The project is ongoing





# **Zero Emission Infrastructure and Rolling Stock**



## **Background**

Project is a purchase of battery electric buses and related infrastructure

#### **Benefit**

This project reduces greenhouse gas emissions and grows the economy

#### **Apportionment**

 This amendment will obligate \$393K in CMAQ funding, \$18.8M in Carbon Reduction funds and \$3.3M in state funding

#### **Schedule**

This effort is ongoing





## **Urban Transit Systems – Operating Assistance**



## **Background**

Funding to support transit operations in Harford County

#### **Benefit**

Provides transit service in Harford County

## **Apportionment**

 This amendment will obligate \$4.6M in 5307 funding and \$4.6M in local match funds to FY 2025

#### **Schedule**

This funding covers CY 2024 and 2025 operating assistance





## **MARC Facilities**



## **Background**

- Project includes improvement and equipment for MARC maintenance facilities and improvements to MARC stations
- This request updates the project description and justification of the TIP page

#### **Benefit**

Supports MARC state of good repair and customer experience

## **Apportionment**

This amendment will add \$28M in 5337 funding and \$7M in state match

#### **Schedule**

Various projects are ongoing





## Francis Scott Key Bridge Transit Incentives



## **Background**

- Pilot program to support transit incentives for businesses and residents impacted by the Francis Scott Key bridge collapse
- Program will offer short-term cost sharing incentives to employers who participate in transit pass subsidization

#### **Benefit**

Incentivizes employers to provide transit benefits

## **Apportionment**

 This amendment will obligate \$1M in CMAQ funds and \$250K in state match

#### **Schedule**

Funding will be obligated in FY 2025
