## BALTIMORE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION BOARD RESOLUTION #17-8

## ENDORSEMENT OF ROUND 8B COOPERATIVE FORECASTING PROCESS THROUGH 2040 FOR USE IN LOCAL AND REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AND AIR QUALITY PLANNING PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, encompassing the Baltimore Urbanized Area, and includes official representatives of the cities of Annapolis and Baltimore, the counties of Anna Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford, Howard, and Queen Anne's as well as representatives of the Maryland Department of Transportation, the Maryland Department of the Environment, the Maryland Department of Planning, and the Maryland Transit Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metropolitan Planning Organization has the responsibility for developing future estimates of travel demand in the Baltimore region and approving conformity analysis of the Baltimore Regional Transportation Plan and the Transportation Improvement Program for the Baltimore region; and

WHEREAS, in connection with these responsibilities, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board established the Cooperative Forecasting Group to develop a consensus among State, local and regional planners regarding the current estimates and long-range projections for growth and development in the Baltimore region; and

WHEREAS, the previously endorsed Round 8A forecasts have been updated to reflect the most current socioeconomic development in the Baltimore region. These forecasts which consist of data for population, households and employment for small geographic areas, called transportation analysis zones (TAZ), capture the development projected in earlier forecasts and any new development; and

WHEREAS, Queen Anne's County is now a member of the Metropolitan Planning Organization and will be included in this forecast round. It is the southwestern portion of the county that is now integrated into the Metropolitan Planning Organization boundary, and it is this section that is included in the forecasting process. The section includes Kent Island and Grasonville and is comprised of five Census Tracts that form the boundaries of four new TAZs; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Forecasting Group has recommended to the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board a set of forecasts termed Round 8B, developed at the 2010 transportation analysis zone structure, for use in transportation and air quality planning activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of socioeconomic forecasting analysis is to provide inputs to decision makers to assist with determining the overall travel demand and air quality effects of growth, at the regional level, on future year highway and transit networks; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board endorses the Round 8B cooperative forecasting process for use in transportation and air quality planning in the Baltimore region as provided in Attachment 1.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, approved the aforementioned resolution at its August 23, 2016 meeting.
