

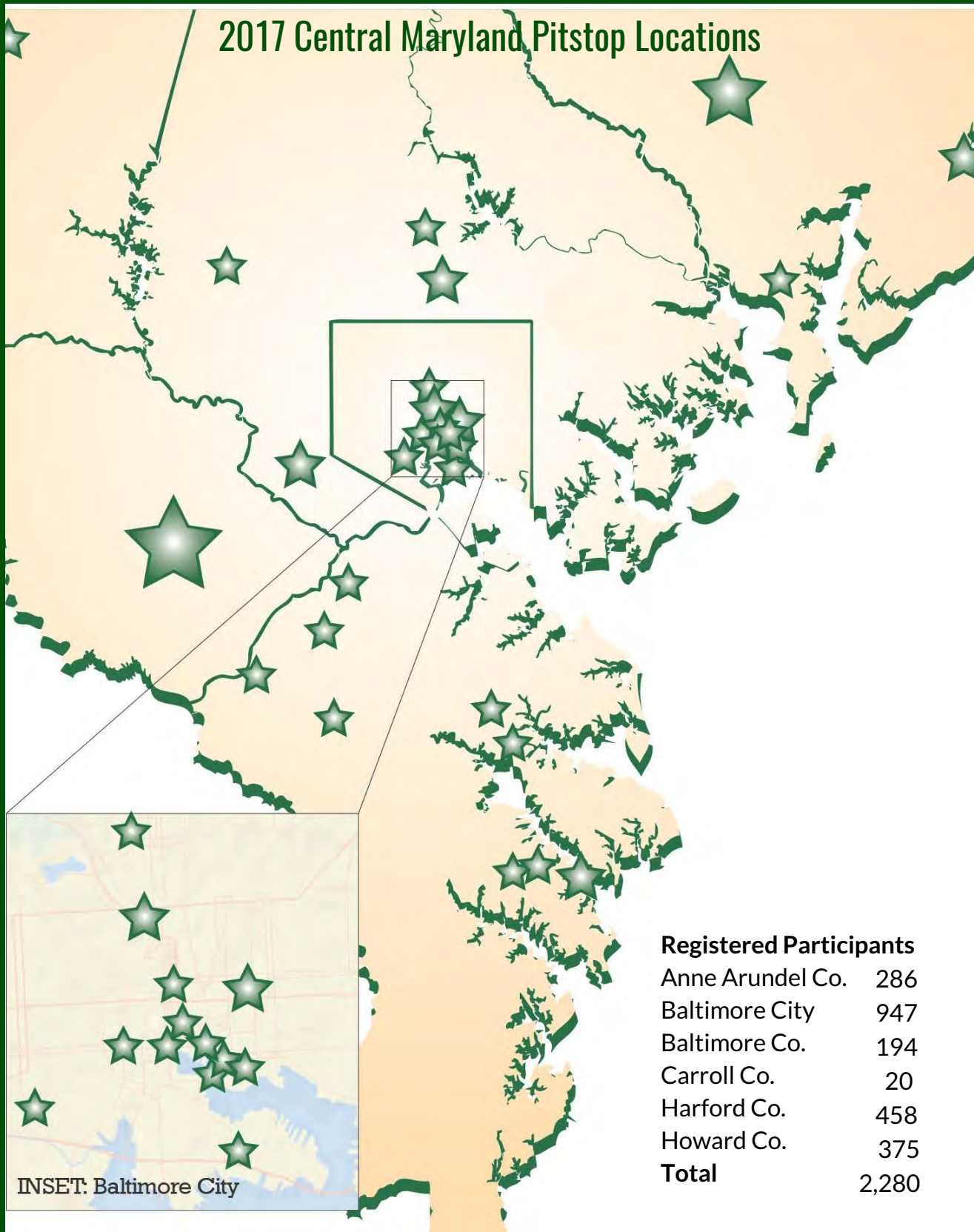

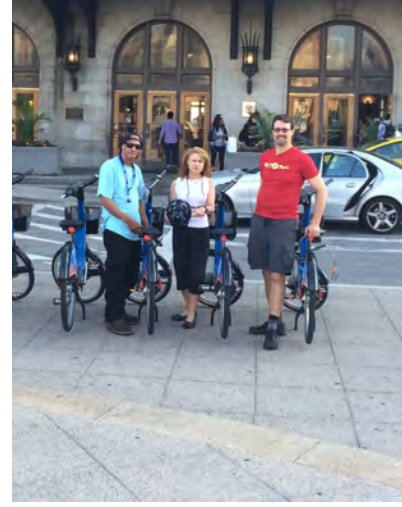
Central Maryland Bike to Work Day 2017 Recap



Bike to Work Day is a national event that takes place on the third Friday in May. Baltimore City and Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford, and Howard Counties participate regionally.



Bike to Work Day is a time to celebrate the bicycle as a legitimate and fun means of transportation. It's an opportunity for novice cyclists to try two-wheeled commuting and a chance for veteran riders to share fellowship. Every May since 1997, the Baltimore Metropolitan Council and its member jurisdictions have organized Bike to Work Day in the Baltimore region. Growing each year, Bike to Work Day 2017 saw over 2,200 cyclists—a new record—meeting at dozens of locations throughout the Greater Baltimore region.



Bike to Work Day 2017 also featured the participation of many of the region's employers, both large and small. Several hosted pitstops, places where riders could grab a bite, have a drink, and talk with other cyclists of their love of two-wheeling. Many organizations encouraged employees to bike by offering incentives such as free meals, relaxed dress codes, and contests that offered valuable prizes. The majority, however, supported the effort by contributing cash, services, or prizes.

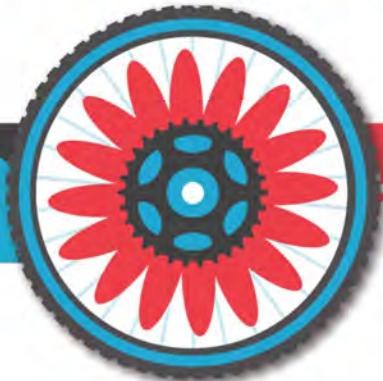
