The Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB), supported by the Baltimore Metropolitan Council (BMC), will host the 2019 Baltimore Regional New Mobility Transportation Forum on Wednesday, March 13th, at the University of Baltimore H. Mebane Turner Learning Commons/Town Hall in Baltimore, MD.

Recent technological and social trends are converging to impact the way people and goods move. The significant growth of new services like Uber, Lyft, Zipcar, Byrd, and Lime; advancements in electric and alternative powertrains and lighter weight materials; data management and artificial intelligence; and the quest for connected and autonomous vehicle technologies are propelling this convergence. The Baltimore region must prepare for these advancements and new technologies and begin building a better understanding of how the emergence of a new ecosystem of mobility could offer us faster, cheaper, cleaner, safer, more efficient, and more customized travel experience to our citizens and businesses.

In preparation for the update of the Baltimore Region's Transportation Plan, *Maximize 2045*, The BRTB invites you to attend a half-day forum to start the discussion of new mobility options that are emerging, and how and when, they may begin to shape our region.

This forum is intended to:

- Identify what's coming and how fast of a transition must we and can we make;
- Determine how a future mobility system centered around connected and driverless vehicles and shared mobility might change our landscape;
- Bring together transit, auto, shared mobility, freight, and IT leaders from around the region to discuss these opportunities and challenges and share state-of-the-art strategies that might help the transportation network better serve the Baltimore Region.
