Survey

- General Survey Comments (33 received)
 - Access paths to neighboring roads/additional trail connections would be beneficial
 - Potential conflicts with proximity to industrial areas
 - Parking near trail access points is needed
 - Concern for general bike/ped safety
 - Need for amenities (restrooms, water stops, bike repair stations)

 - Potential wildlife viewing locations














Selected Alignment: Modified Halethorpe Alternative







