How do you feel about these potential sign upgrades?

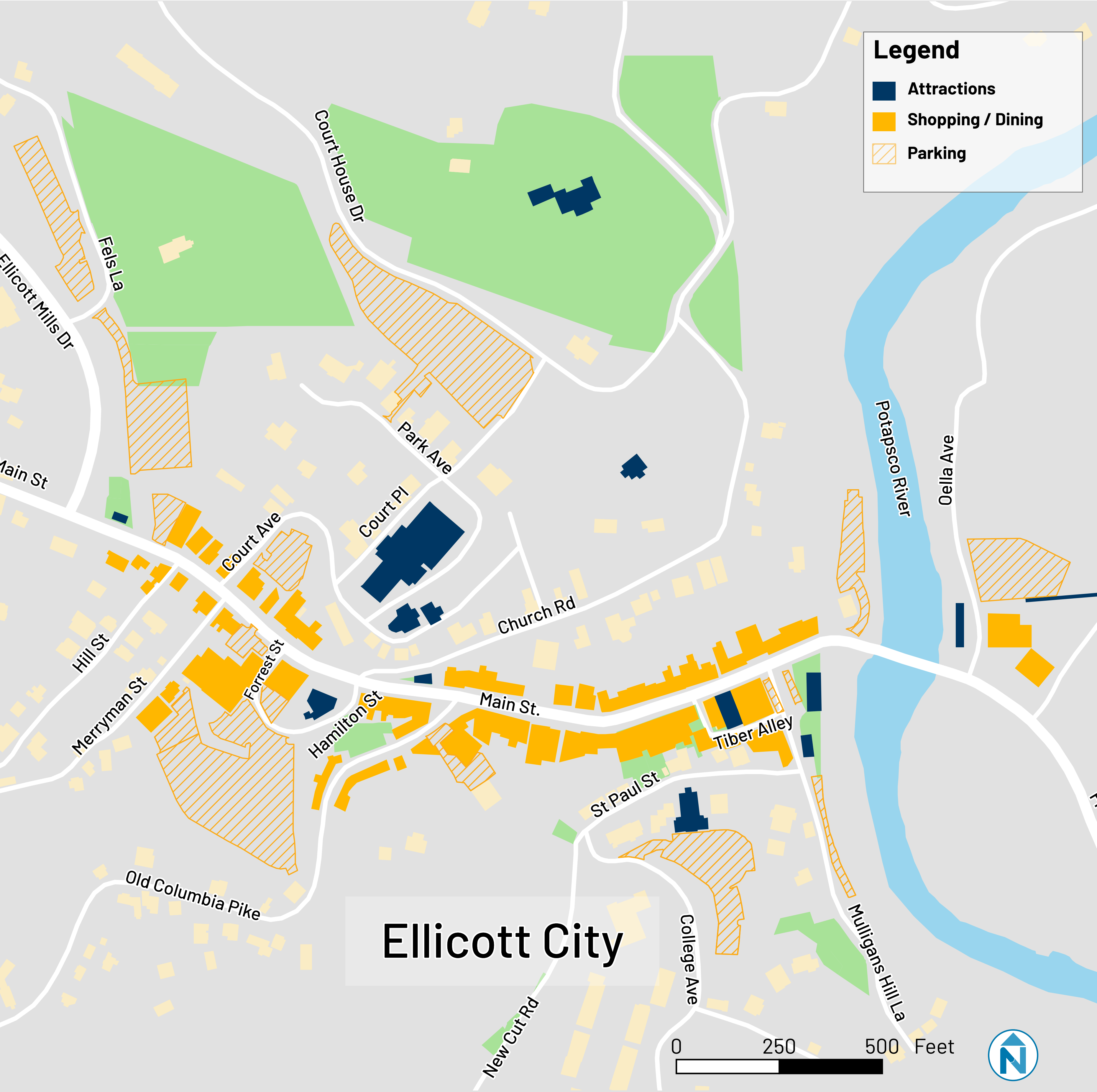

Update parking signage to also show various amenities such as EV parking stalls, and connections to hiking/biking trails.

Place a dot along the arrows, based on strength of preference

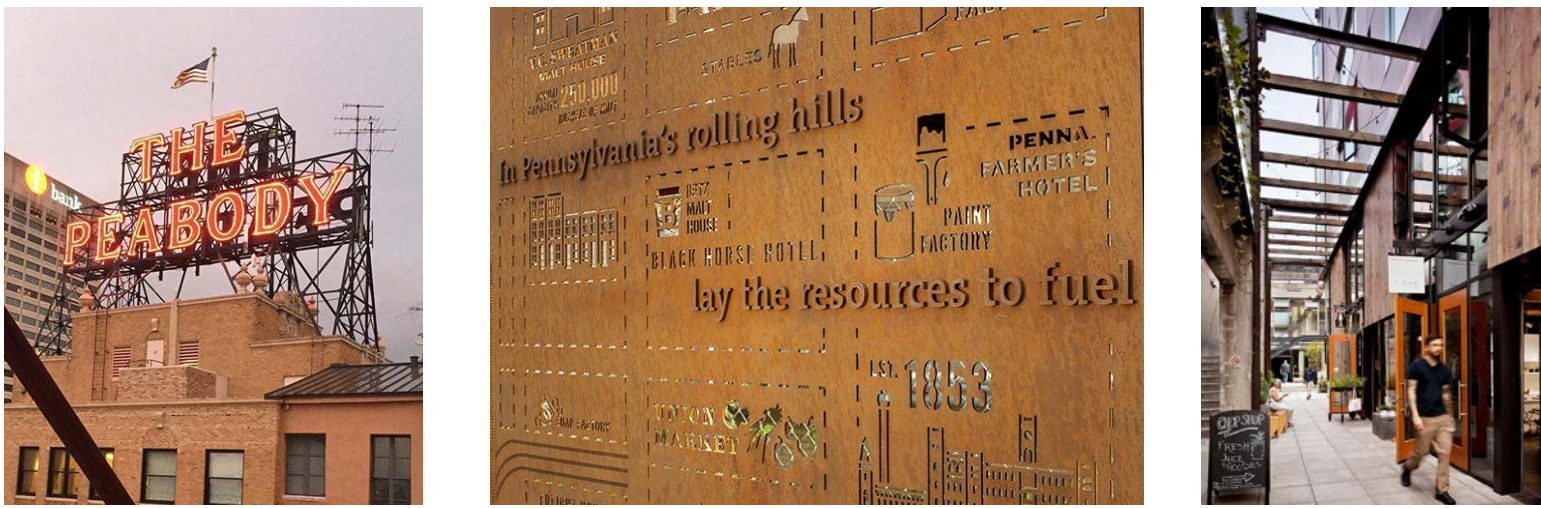
INDUSTRIAL

MODERN

This style is characterized by ornamentation, intricacy, and asymmetry.
