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DISCUSSION

Main point of discussion was to share information on COVID19 operations, disruptions and supply chain demands:

- a. Bobbie (HarfordCPS) shared that they have decided to continue with virtual classrooms through December. Students can come in for help with schoolwork and to get a meal. The schedule is likely to be Monday Friday from 8-2pm. Main reasons for not opening appear to be challenges with social distancing and many are not comfortable with returning (predominately teachers).
- b. Kerrie (FrederickCPS) shared that they have not decided what they are doing for the Fall.
- c. Susan (CarolineCPS) stated that they have not decided what they are doing for the Fall either.
- d. Laly (MontgomeryCPS) said they are 100% virtual for the Fall and anticipate that they will revisit that decision periodically. They are currently looking for clear masks. Nancy shared success with ClearMask. They are good quality masks and the company has been very responsive.
- e. Brynn (St. Mary'sCPS) said they also have not make any decision about the Fall. They are getting their e-misters from Daycon. They will be used to disinfect the buildings.
- f. Nancy (CarrollCPS) shared that they have made no decision about Fall reopening but have a deadline of August 6th to make that decision. Surveys indicated that parents want to return but teachers do not.
